

European WEEE Regulation 2012/19/EU

Collection and Recycling Arrangements in Italy

Under the Italian Legislative Decree 49/2014 - Waste Electric and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations. Pall provides arrangements for the collection, treatment, recycling and recovery of any electric and electronic equipment bought new from Pall, when at the end of its life that equipment finally becomes waste. Waste electrical or electronic equipment of this type is referred to as WEEE.

Pall Italy is member and has established a recycling contract with European Recycling Platform (ERP Italy, one of the authorized Compliance Schemes operating in Italy), and will cover any costs of treatment, recycling and recovery of the equipment on arrival at ERP Italy recycling facility partner, in Italy. WEEE that arises from the purchase of Pall devices is classed as non-hazardous waste based on the materials of construction employed by Pall in its manufacture — unless otherwise indicated on the product label. However, if as the result of use the equipment has been contaminated with a 'hazardous' substance, please dispose of the equipment in line with the hazard present.

In order to meet Italian regulation for waste disposal, please refers to D.lgs 49/2014 art.24 comma 1,2, and 3. You should use one carrier holding a valid Waste Carriers license according to TU Ambiente, D.Lgs. 152/06, or contact ERP Italia directly for the collection. In this case ERP Italy will provide an offer for the collection and transportation of the WEEE.

To comply with Italian Waste Transport Regulations all WEEE must be accompanied by suitable documentation when transported to the recycler. It is your responsibility to arrange and pay for the costs of collection and transportation to recycling facility.
