PREVENTION: Each of our subsidiaries operates an Environmental Team to:


1. Conduct our operations with respect for the environment,

COMPLIANCE PROGRAMS: Each site will establish an environmental management system to ensure our requirements are fully implemented.

AUDITING: Pall Corporation audits its operations periodically to determine compliance with the policies and procedures detailed in our manuals and to ensure consistency between our plants and the highest levels of excellence in our programs.
