

HSPA181 Hydraluic Fluid Purifier Designed for Aircraft Maintenance

The Pall HSPA181 Purifier offers operators and MRO shops a safe and environmentally friendly solution to maintain air craft hydraulic fluid cleanliness.

Aircraft hydraulic fluids (Skydrol¹ and HyJet²) are susceptible to contamination by water, solid particles, chlorinated solvents and air and contaminated hydraulic fluid means damage and corrosion in vital system components. Insufficient purity can even lead to expensive grounding of the aircraft. Storage and subsequent disposal of the contaminated fluid brings environmental penalties and increased cost.

A breakthrough in preventive maintenance, the Pall Mobile Hydraulic Fluid Purifier (HSPA series), operates where it is needed, when it is needed leaving hydraulic fluid free of contaminants within a few hours.



Linked to the aircraft hydraulic systems like a ground power unit, the Pall Mobile Hydraulic Fluid Purifier (HSPA) is a breakthrough in preventive maintenance saving the operator money and time by ensuring operation of aircraft without down time caused by fluid contamination.

- Removes particulate by using a high performance (B5(c)≥1000) aircraft-grade filter element to polish the fluid before discharge back to the system reservoir
