European Directive: 'RoHS2' (2011/65/EU) and amendment 2015/863 restricts the use of the ten hazardous substances below in various types of electrical and electronic equipment placed on the market in the European Union:

- Lead
- Cadmium
- Mercury
- Hexavalent Chromium
- Polybrominated Biphenyl (PBB)
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ether (PBDE)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP)
- Benzyl Butyl Phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP)

Many Pall products are not electrical or electronic devices and therefore not within scope of this requirement. However, Pall provides information, on request, related to the above substances to assist users employing our products in the manufacture of electrical or electronic equipment. This information is based on statements from relevant suppliers related to these materials, and through additional checks within Pall at the manufacturing site.
