Under the **UK Waste Electric and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations** (2013), Pall provides arrangements for the collection, treatment, recycling and recovery of any electric and electronic equipment bought new from Pall, when at the end of its life that equipment finally becomes waste. Waste electrical or electronic equipment of this type is referred to as WEEE.

Pall drives for very competitive pricing on all our products. Therefore, when these requirements were introduced, instead of increasing the prices of our products, Pall decided to share these environmental costs with our customers. Because, Pall believes in being transparent with you on any environmental costs, please be aware that our approach to these environmental costs is:

- Pall pays for the costs of treatment, recycling and recovery of the WEEE to meet the targets set by the WEEE Regulations;
- Pall pays for the costs of data management and reporting to the Environment Agency to demonstrate compliance with all administrative requirements of the WEEE Regulations;
- The user pays for transportation of his WEEE to Pall's appointed recycler in the UK.

Pall has a recycling contract with the 'Thinkstep Compliance Ltd' scheme operator / B2B WEEE and covers any costs of treatment, recycling and recovery of the equipment on arrival at the designated European Advanced Recycling Network (EARN) recycling facility in the UK. All New WEEE that arises from the purchase of Pall products is classed as non-hazardous waste, unless otherwise indicated on the product label, and does not contain Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs) to class it as hazardous WEEE. As the waste holder, it is your responsibility to confirm that the waste Pall equipment has not become hazardous during the product use. For example, if the equipment has become contaminated during use, please follow the recommended decontamination procedure or dispose of the equipment in line with the hazard present.

As indicated, it is your responsibility to arrange and pay for costs of collection and transportation to the EARN recycler.
